## INFORMATION RE SKYLINE RECONFIGURATION AND SKYLINE FUTURE STUDENTS

### Skyline High School Registration Information for Incoming Ninth and Tenth Graders

#### General Information

In September of 2016 The Granite District Board of Education approved a proposal made by The Skyline Network to reconfigure grades in member schools. For Skyline this means that for the 2017-2018 school year we will be welcoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade students to the school. We are excited about having 9<sup>th</sup> grade students attend Skyline. A transition team has been created and we have been busy working on adjustments to the building, curriculum changes, and program adjustments to prepare for the incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade students. It will be an exciting time and school year.

#### Information Meetings

We have planned two parent meetings to discuss the transition from junior high to high school. These meetings are to share information about programs at Skyline. They will include a time to ask questions and begin to become acquainted with the building for those interested.

- January 10, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Skyline Auditorium is for Parents of Incoming 10<sup>th</sup> grade students.
- January 11, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Skyline auditorium is for Parents of incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade students.

## Open Enrollment

The open enrollment period began December 1, 2016. It continues through February 21, 2017. Students that live outside of the Skyline attendance area can apply to attend Skyline High School by completing an Open Enrollment application and returning it to the Skyline High School main office prior to the close of business February 21, 2017.

Applications must include:

- A completed application.
- A \$5.00 processing fee.

Upon receipt, applications are date stamped. Applications are approved on a first come, first served basis until all available slots are filled. Historically we have denied very few applications.

## Registration Information

Counselors will be visiting Churchill and Wasatch Junior High Schools to deliver registration cards to students. Skyline counselors will visit English classes at Churchill and Wasatch on the dates listed below;

- Churchill Junior- January 25 and 26, 2017 Skyline counselors will visit CJHS to drop off registration cards.
- February 1 and 2, 2017 Skyline Counselors will pick up registration cards for incoming 9th and 10th grade students.
- Wasatch Junior- January 24, 2017 Skyline counselors will visit Wasatch to drop off registration cards.
- January 31, 2017 Skyline Counselors will return to pick up registration cards for incoming 9th and 10th grade students.
- Special Permit-Out of Boundary Registration Meeting
- February 23, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. in the Skyline Auditorium there will be a meeting for students on special permit to discuss registration questions and turn in cards.

## International Baccalaureate Programme (IB)

- January 3 and February 1, 2017 there will be two information meetings to discuss the IB Programme for those interested. The meetings begin at 6:00 p.m. in the Auditorium.
